<i>Paph mastersianum</i>		self	<p>The plant used to make this population was an extra select example of this species from Taiwan. It was purchased by the owner of the Orchid Zone. It was one of the finest examples of this species he had seen so he promptly selfed it. The color was amazing. We purchased the plant with the pod on it when he was closing OZ. These should be fantastic.</p>	¥24,150
<i>Paph mastersianum</i>		sibling	<p>This cross was made with two exceptional plants from the Orchid Zone, back when Terry still owned it. We selected the parents from a group of several dozen. Huge flowers on tall stems. This should produce some of the best examples of this species ever.</p>	¥24,150
<i>Phrag caudatum</i>		x sib	<p>We bloomed out dozens of Phrag caudatum plants from the Orchid Zone and chose the best two to make this sibling cross. These should be outstanding examples of this long petaled species. We expect petals over 70 cm long from the best of these.</p>	¥20,700

<p><i>Phrag wallisii</i> (<i>warszewiczianum</i>)</p>		<p>OZ Select' x sibling</p>	<p>This is a sibling cross of two select clones we purchased from the Orchid Zone. We chose plants with great color and long petals. Hopefully the best of these seedlings will have petals approaching 80 cm long. This is an easy species to grow and bloom.</p>	<p>¥20,700</p>
<p><i>Paph fairrieanum</i></p>	 <p>Red Flame'</p>	 <p>Red Rocket'</p>	<p>Red Flame' is a select plant from the Orchid Zone, chosen for its very bold stripes. 'Red Rocket' is perhaps the largest and fullest fairrieanum we have ever seen. The dorsal is wider than any fairrieanum we have some across before. The plant is extremely vigorous and so are these seedlings. Expecting many awards from this cross.</p>	<p>¥27,600</p>
<p><i>Paph fairrieanum album</i></p>	 <p>Montrachet'</p>	 <p>Dijon' AM/AOS</p>	<p>Montrachet' is our best album of this species. Very large with good intensity of green color and a pure white background with no pink blush. 'Dijon' AM/AOS is the first fairrieanum album to receive an AM in over 10 years. It is very flat and has a clean white background. It is also extremely vigorous. This cross should produce the next generation of award winners! ***Ready Spring 2019***</p>	<p>¥27,600</p>



<p><i>Paph fairrieanum album</i></p>	 <p>Bacchus'</p>	 <p>Dijon' AM/AOS</p>	<p>Bacchus' and 'Dijon' are siblings from a cross we made a few years ago. A high percentage of this cross was very vigorous, these were probably the most vigorous. They both bloomed about 16 months out of flask. <p><i>Paph fairrieanum album</i></p>	 <p>Dijon' AM/AOS</p>	<p>self</p>	<p>Obviously, we were very excited about our AM/AOS on 'Dijon'. We made 3 crosses including this selfing. Many fairrieanum album have a pink blush. The pink is so pale on this flower that it is barely visible. Selfing this flower should give some offspring that have absolutely no pink. <p><i>Paph rothschildianum</i></p>	 <p>Paradise Island'</p>	 <p>Paradise Lost' AM/AOS</p>	<p>We had the good fortune of close access to the Orchid Zone over the last few years. We were able to acquire many of the finest rothschildianum clones and add them to our stud bench. 'Paradise Island' was not presented for judging, but it would have scored a high AM. Very large, flat flowers. 'Paradise Lost' is perhaps one of the best examples of the species in the world. A once in a lifetime plant! This should be a fantastic cross. 			<p>This species is easy to grow, and forms wonderful specimen plants. However, it is not easy to propagate from seed. The plants do not set pods well and the germination is usually poor. We have been fortunate enough to get pretty good yield from this cross...enough that we are able to release a limited number of flasks. Once these are gone it will be a while before we are able to offer any again.</p>

<p>Paph</p>			<p>Mem. Sabrina Mark 'Rich Canvas' is from the breeding bench at the Orchid Zone. Terry selected it for its size, flat form and very glossy texture. Mem. Sabrina Mark is a proven parent that has produced some outstanding hybrids. Crossing this to the German bred Eyecatcher is an obvious choice. This cross should produce huge flowers with potential for bold spots. One of the best spotted complex we have ever produced!</p>	<p style="text-align: right;">¥34,500</p>
<p>Paph</p>			<p>Both of these parents are very vigorous. Chocolate Eagle has proven to be a wonderful parent so far, producing offspring with very wide petals and great color. Jenna Marie is an excellent parent with a great track record. These should be fantastic spotted reds with tall stems. Very high potential here.</p>	<p style="text-align: right;">¥34,500</p>
<p>Paph</p>			<p>(Emerald Lake x Pacific Shamrock) has a very flat flower with broad petals. Here we have put another shot of Pacific Shamrock onto this hybrid. The Pacific Shamrock we used has intense green color, great round form and heavy texture. It is also very flat. Paph			<p>Vogue Wonder has large, flat flowers with great color and wide petals on a tall stem. Hawaiian Volcano is a new line of breeding with unique color. This is an interesting cross with potential for new and exciting color patterns. It is hard to predict what we might see but we are hoping for big spots on the petals and lots of green. We can't wait to start blooming these!</p>	\$150.00
Paph			<p>Paph Stone Crazy 'Pinot Gris' really impressed the judges. The flower had just opened the day of judging, and they said to bring it back someday for an FCC. Paph fairrieanum 'Red Wonder' was part of the AQ/AOS for Hillsview. Tremendous red color in the dorsal. This hybrid should produce flowers that range from sunset tones through red. Complex hybrids with fairrieanum always produce wonderful flowers. Highly recommended!</p>	\$200.00

<p>Paph</p>			<p>Paph Temptation 'Lehua's Green Joy' is more compact than typical Temptation plants. It has striking green flowers. Crossed with an outstanding philippinense album we should see some wonderful greens with 6-7 flowers per spike. <p>Paph</p>			<p>Our Leonard's Pride received an 87.4 point SM/CSA this year. One judge told me that if the fifth flower had been fully open it would have received a Gold Medal. This plant draws attention everywhere we display it...the flowers are HUGE! AOS judges wanted to score it at our local show, convinced it was an FCC. We knew it could flower even better so we said no. We have tried to set pods on this plant every year with very limited success. Finally we had some good yield crossed with our very best roth. <p>Paph</p>	<p>Valwin 'Intense'</p>	 <p>Chocolate Eagle 'Burgundy' HCC/AOS</p>	<p>Valwin 'Intense' is a stud plant from the Orchid Zone. We forgot to get a photo when it was in bloom. Very dark red flowers. Chocolate Eagle is one of the most vigorous complex Paphs we have seen. It is also a huge flower...15 cm across. Its color is variable depending on the season when it blooms; more red in the winter and more spotted in the dorsal in the summer. Yes, it blooms in the summer and just about any other time. It has produced excellent red offspring so far in breeding.</p>	<p>¥27,600</p>
<p>Paph</p>	 <p>Crush Strawberry</p>	 <p>Pacific Shamrock 'Magnificent'</p>	<p>We hope to see shapely whites from this cross, but there may also be yellows. Some flowers may have small spots or stippling as the pod parent has very small red spots. 'Magnificent' is the very best Pacific Shamrock with great form and heavy texture. It was used to make some of the Orchid Zone's finest hybrids over the years. Only 3 flasks left.</p>	<p>¥34,500</p>
